



# CVSan Recycles Day

August 5, 2017, 8:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m. at Canyon Middle School

**RECYCLE:** Pharmaceuticals, sharps, e-waste, and household hazardous waste (HHW): paint supplies, pesticides, etc. For complete details and instructions, please visit [www.cvsan.org](http://www.cvsan.org). Free to Alameda County residents! Bring photo ID or WMAC/utility bill to event. Please have items readily available in your vehicle in order of drop-off stations - pharmaceuticals & sharps in passenger seat (Station 2), e-waste closest to opening of trunk (Station 3), and HHW farthest back in trunk (Station 4).

**FREE COMPOST:** three 1-cubic foot bags per CVSan household (single-family or multi-family apartment) or business, per event. Supplies are limited and will be distributed on a 1st come, 1st served basis. Vehicle loading assistance is available. Participation in the Recycle Collection is not required to receive free compost, however you must be a CVSan resident or business (bring ID or bill). For CVSan residents only picking up compost, please be in right lane.
