1: REVISION TO THE RFP DOCUMENT

SECTION 6: PROPOSAL EVALUATION PROCESS

CVSan will select an evaluation committee comprised of staff, consultants, CVSan Board Member(s), and/or outside agency representatives. This evaluation committee will conduct a detailed evaluation of the proposals and provide a recommendation to the District Board, considering all of the factors below. The District values cost-effectiveness, however the recommendation of the evaluation committee will be based on overall value, including all of the factors below. The District Board will review the evaluation team's evaluation report and select the future contractor. The District Board is not obligated to accept the recommendation of the evaluation committee and may act in the best interests of the community, in its sole discretion. CVSan staff and its consultant will be responsible for negotiating the Draft Franchise Agreement. The Board will ultimately be responsible for approval of the new Franchise Agreement.
